The Maronite Patriarch, Cardinal Beshara Al Rahi, declared during the announcement of the "Memorandum on Lebanon and Active Neutrality' that there are three interdependent dimensions: the first one is Lebanon's definitive abstinence from entering into alliances, political conflicts, and wars on the regional and international level, in addition to the abstention of any country from interfering in its affairs, dominating it or occupying it; The second one is Lebanon's sympathy for human rights & causes and peoples' freedom, especially the Arab affairs around which there is an international consensus in the United Nations; thereby, Lebanon continues to defend the right of the Palestinian people. The third dimension revolves around strengthening the Lebanese State to be a strong state with its army, institutions, justice and internal unity in order to guarantee its internal security on the one hand and defend itself against any terrestrial, marine or aerial attack from Israel or any other country on the other hand.

I appealed to the United Nations, asking it to work on re-establishing Lebanon's independence and unity, implementing international resolutions, and declaring its neutrality; as it is the guarantee of its unity and its historical positioning. Only a neutral Lebanon will be able to defend the rights of the Arab peoples and the Issue of peace, and to play a role in sound relations between the countries of the Middle East and Europe thanks to its location on the Mediterranean shore. Get acquainted with Zgharta

My book doesn't constitute a historical research, and there are many references available for those who want to learn about the history of families. However, I have drawn on the civil status registers for four years and more; I especially learned about the family's transfer from their place to Zgharta detail.

It must be noted that my work is accurate and truthful; it is also characterized by a simple style and a modern and brief narrative.

The rule is that the registration number (i.e. the register) must not be changed, and the registers shall be preserved in Zgharta's Personal Status department. As per the number of males — females, the register is always subjected to an annual increase In the percentage that is added to the number. This factor is not important, unlike the three abovementioned titles.

I consider, in all modesty, that this work represents the cornerstone for those who, after us, will be interested in staying informed of the updates related to the personal status registers.

We are all in the service of our city Zgharta — Ehden and the district.






Out of this area, a 1500 square meters site located next to the houses belongs to the endowment.

Prefabricated houses can be rented on a summery or annual basis. But it is vital that we do not lose a lessee who didn't find a house for rent or a bedchamber in Ehden. This is a crucial factor, and the most important thing is reviving the economy for the townspeople and refraining from distorting the beautiful scenery with reinforced concrete and buildings. In fact, the views of house roofs made of wood or brick are spectacular. Although they are available in limited numbers in Ehden city, however they are spread throughout the majority of mountainous touristic places in our homeland Lebanon. I wish the municipality would work on making a brick roof for every building in Ehden city.









Construction of the building of the municipality of Zgharta — Ehden


Construction of the municipalities' union building - district of Zgharta
